Biography

Sally Stone is the professor of Adaptive Reuse and Innovative Pedagogies at the Manchester School of Architecture. Her work explores sustainable adaptation, issues of heritage, the history of adaptation, and the disconnected yet similar approaches that artist and architects take to the existing built environment. She is the author of *Inside Information* (RIBA Publications 2021), *UnDoing Buildings* (Routledge, 2019), *ReReadings Volumes 1 +2* (RIBA Publications, 2004, 2018), and *Emerging Practices in Pedagogy* (Routledge, 2021). She is the leader of the MA Architecture and Adaptive Reuse programme at the Manchester School of Architecture.

Biography

Mary Anne Beecher, Ph.D., is a Professor in the Department of Design at The Ohio State University. Dr. Beecher has extensive experience as a scholar, a design educator and an administrator in both the United States and Canada. She has taught at Iowa State University, the University of Oregon, and the University of Manitoba, where she was also the Department Head of the Interior Design Department from 2008-2013. She served as the Chair of the Department of Design at Ohio State for nine years. Dr. Beecher has written critical essays on such wide-ranging topics as the shifting ethical terrain of today's interior design practice; the political nature of interior space; the significance of naming practices in interior design education.

Biography

Jian Kang has been a full professor since 2003. He is President of the International Institute of Acoustics and Vibration (IIAV), and he also chairs the European Acoustics Association Technical Committee for Noise, and the EU COST Action on Soundscape of European Cities and Landscapes. He obtained his PhD from the University of Cambridge and has worked in architectural and environmental acoustics for 40 years, with 80+ research projects, 800+ publications, 90+ engineering/consultancy projects, and 20+ patents. He is recipient of the ERC Advanced Grant Award, working internationally on developing Soundscape Indices. He is Fellow of Royal Academy of Engineering, and a Member of Academia Europaea.
